

One day farmers training on Cultivation of aromatic crops for sustainability under central sector scheme

One day farmers training on “Cultivation of aromatic crops for sustainability” during December 29, 2018 at Dehgam under Central Sector Scheme, DASD Calicut, Kerala has been conducted by the Directorate of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants Research (DMAPR), Boriavi, Anand, Gujarat. The aim of the training is to provide information to farmers with recent development in Aromatic plants and essential oil extraction. Seventy-six farmers participated from Kothi, Dehgam as well from nearby villages. Farmers and experts visited FLDs of palmarosa and lemongrass in Kothi, Krishnanagar. Exposure for essential oil extraction unit and proper utilization of residue have been given to farmers. The program was successfully concluded by Dr. P. L. Saran, P.I. (CSS), Sr. Scientist, with Dr. K. A. Kalariya (P.I. TSP) and Dr. R. P. Meena, Scientist, Plant Pathology from ICAR-DMAPR, Boriavi.
