With the objective to provide the livelihood support of the tribal farmers, a One Day training programme on “Promotion of medicinal plants cultivation in tribal areas of Gujarat” was conducted at Galibili, Tal. Ghoghamba, Dist. Panchmahals on 09.03.2022. This programme was organized under Tribal Sub Plan Scheme operational at ICAR-Directorate of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants Research, Anand, Gujarat. The programme was inaugurated with a floral well come



of resource persons from ICAR-DMAPR, Anand followed by floral welcome of a progressive farmer Sh. Vartan Bhai Rathva, Sarapanch, Galibili and Sh. Jitu Bhai Chavda, Gram Sevak, Galibili. Dr. K.A. Kalariya, Nodal Officer, TSP, ICAR-DMAPR welcomed farmers, introduced the activities under TSP scheme and

briefed how addition income can be gained through cultivation of medicinal and aromatic plants. He also explained package of practices and economics of cultivation of several important medicinal plants. Dr. R.P. Meena, Scientist, described disease and its management and cultivation techniques of selected aromatic crops. Dr. Prince Choyal briefed impact of climate change on cultivation MAPs. Total 50 numbers of Water Storage Tanks (500 L capacity) were distributed among all registered beneficiary tribal farmers in this programme.
