

## One Day Training programme for Tribal Farmers under TSP held at Village Datoi, Tal. Ghoghamba, Dist. Panchmahal 28.06.2022, Anand, Gujarat

One Day Training programme on “Promotion of medicinal plants cultivation in tribal areas of Gujarat” was conducted on 28.06.2022 at Datoi, Tal. Ghoghamba, Dist. Panchmahal. This programme was organized under Tribal Sub Plan Scheme operational at ICAR-Directorate of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants Research, Anand, Gujarat. Dr. K.A. Kalariya, Sr. Scientist and Nodal Officer, TSP, ICAR-DMAPR, briefed about the TSP scheme and described agro-techniques of cultivation of several MAPs



suitable for the region. Participants were benefited by experts covering different aspects of MAPs cultivation. Dr. P. L. Saran, Principal Scientist, ICAR-DMAPR gave detailed information on package of practices of important aromatic crops and covered marketing aspects of the MAP produce. Dr. B. B. Basak, Sr. Scientist, ICAR-DMAPR emphasized on organic

cultivation of MAPs. To make the training more interactive and beneficial, officers from horticulture department, Gujarat Government, were invited in this training programme. Sh. Yogesh Khant and Sh. Kaplesh Patel, both Horticulture Officer, Godhra, Govt. of Gujarat gave detailed information on how to avail various



schemes for horticultural crops intended for MAPs offered by Gujarat Government. Total 50 tribal farmers from village Datoi participated in this programme. Training kits, face mask and an 8x6m sized high quality HDPE tarpaulin sheet were distributed among all registered beneficiary tribal participants in this training programme. The programme was concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by Dr. S.B. Prajapati, ICAR-DMAPR, Anand.
