One Day Farmers Training on “Promotion of medicinal plants cultivation in tribal areas of Gujarat” held at Nani Dumli, Chhotaudepur, on 28.12.2022. This programme was conducted under TSP Scheme operational at ICAR-Directorate of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants Research, Anand, Gujarat. Total 100 numbers farmers from nearby villages participated in this training programme. Briefing about the TSP scheme, Dr. K. A. Kalariya, Sr. Scientist and Nodal Officer, TSP, ICAR-DMAPR explained the package of practices of important medicinal plants. Industrial importance and economics of cultivation of important aromatic crops was covered by Dr. P. L. Saran, Principal Scientist, ICAR-DMAPR, Anand. Dr. B.B. Basak, Sr. Scientist, ICAR-DMAPR, Anand spoke on organic cultivation of MAPs. He also explained the procedure to prepare jivamrut and other organic products. He also emphasized on maintaining soil health. Sh. Sanjay Rathva, Extension Officer, Chhotaudepur, Govt. of Gujarat told government schemes for tribals. Live potted plants of MAPs were displayed during this training. A visit to nearby organic farm of a progressive farmer was also arranged. All registered beneficiary tribal participants were given training kits, face mask and tarpaulin sheets during this training programme.
